1. Go to works.bepress.com and click “Start a SelectedWorks Site”.



2. You will be asked to login.

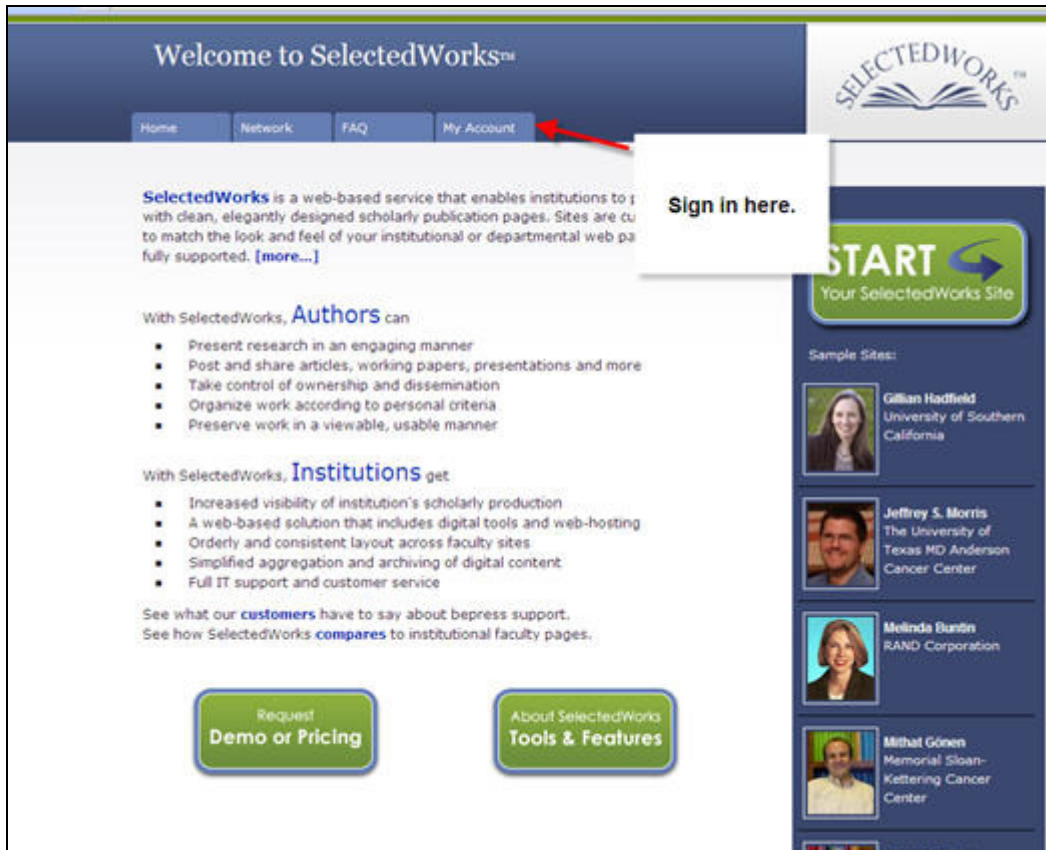

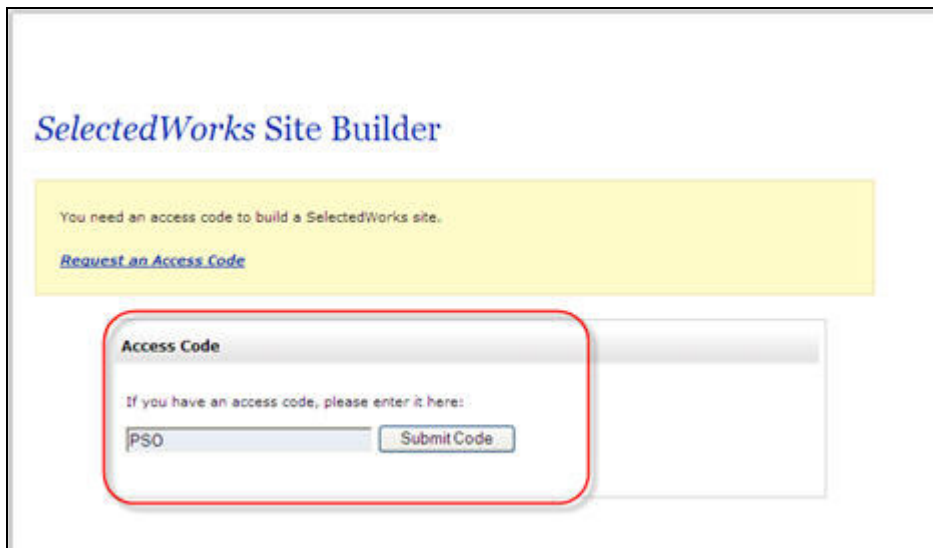
